Responsibility:

To provide mental health support to students so they can have positive learning experiences in school.

Duties:

- Support students and help them build self-regulation and coping skills in one-on-one and small group settings.
- Support student needs by making referrals to outside agencies as needed.
- Facilitate skill building in large group and classroom settings.
- Organize and lead small support groups around themes such as grief, friendship skills, etc.
- Coordinate and oversee STAR (Students Teaching Attitudes of Respect) team activities.
- Collaborate with other agencies to support students and families.
- Build relationships with parents and community through positive and frequent communication, including home visits.
- Communicate with classroom teachers about student needs, concerns and progress
- Attend weekly Student Support Team meetings.
- Submit schedule to director and log student contact time.
- Coordinate transition activities for 6th graders.

Qualifications:

- Minimum of a four-year college degree in a related field; licensure preferred.

Interested candidates must be able to pass a background check and drug test.
